The mill has excellent train (West Coast Mainline from Euston to Birmingham) and road (M1, M25 and A41) connections.


Apsley is the southern suburb of Hemel Hempstead in Hertfordshire. Frogmore Paper Mill is situated just behind the Apsley shops on London Road, a five minute walk from Apsley Train Station. The car park is accessed via Durrant's Hill Road and the main pedestrian entrance is just a short walk away, off Fourdrinier Way.

SATNAV:

CAR users please use postcode HP3 9RG. There are 70 parking spaces just opposite the mill in the Durrant's Hill Road car park. Please note that the car park is pay and display but very reasonably priced:

We have parking for up to two coaches on site. Coach drivers please use HP3 9RW to reach our coach park at the rear of the mill.

Frogmore Paper Mill is operated by the Apsley Paper Trail, a charitable trust founded to conserve the unique industrial heritage of this site in Hemel Hempstead.

In 1803 Frogmore Paper Mill was the place selected by Henry and Sealy Fourdrinier for the trials of their newly patented paper machine. With the successful installation of the world's first ever paper machine at the mill began the paper's industrial revolution leading to the cheap, plentiful paper products that we all use every day of our lives.

Frogmore is still a working paper mill but, as operated by the charity, it is also a visitor, education and community use centre as well. The trust is entirely self-financing and, of course, is not-for-profit with all proceeds from its activities being re-invested in the repair, maintenance and development of the mill and its historic equipment.

Frogmore Paper Mill can offer you room hire and conferencing in a unique and friendly setting at a location that can add unique interest to your event. Any visit is fully customizable and can include: papermaking, a mill tour, a boat trip, a fish and chip or buffet lunch and even a 'paper model boat race' on the back stream if you would like a bit of fun. All facilities are fully wheelchair accessible and are available for rent for a single or half a day, with catering or without and at very reasonable rates.

The Frogmore Forum



Located in the visitor centre it comes fully equipped with free Wifi, video and audio facilities and seats up to 120 people theatre style. There are also tables and comfortable seats for boardroom style meetings.

The Tony Bandle Suite



Located in a separate building onsite, fully self-contained with its own kitchen and toilets, and its own separate access enabling out-of-hours access if booked over a few consecutive days. It also has free Wifi, video and audio facilities and is ideally suited to training sessions with up to 13 laptop desks and office-style chairs. Alternatively it can seat up to 40 people theatre style.
