Weils Disease/Limes Disease	Child/adult	Unlikely risk as the river is fast flowing Children are not allowed in the river Children are advised to wash their hands immediately after this activity and before eating Children not to handle wet boats/ disposed of by APT staff.		L
Abuse from staff and others	Child	Child protection policy in place. Staff and volunteers working with children should be DBS checked and have certificates to prove it.		L
